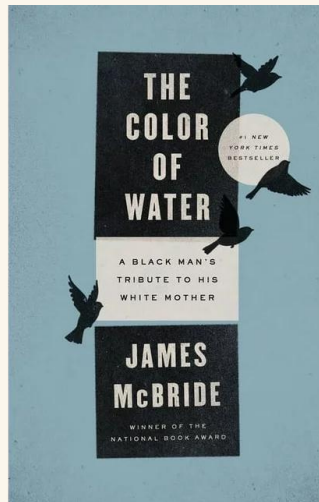

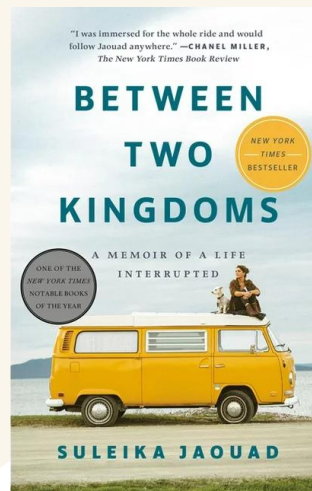

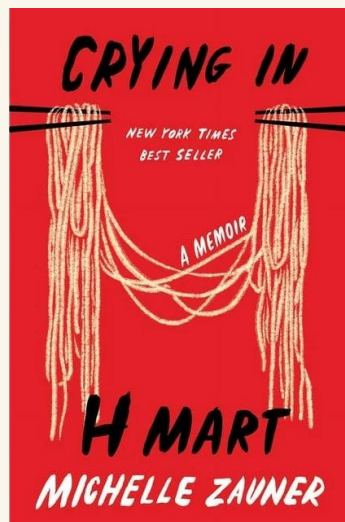
Summer Discussion August 28th



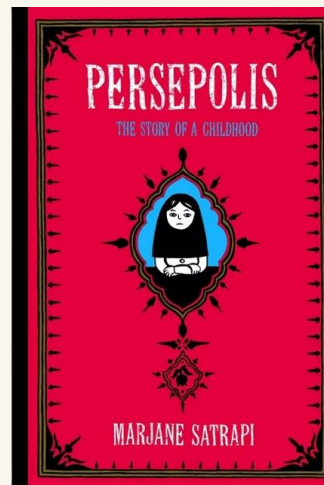
